

# Rationale for Cultural Capital Passport

- All students get at least 2 cultural activities per year
- Students engage in activities that may not be offered at home.
- These activities are deemed to be important as they create a rounded individual
- Students feel rewarded for working well in school
- Learning can take place away from the classroom.
- For students to gain greater place awareness skills.
- Students can adapt to different environments and broaden their aspirations
- Enables students to be more socially mobile.
- Students understanding the professional and social opportunities available to them
